Regarding sexual and reproductive health services, these are offered indirectly through general health awareness activities covering topics such as physical and mental health, education on the prevention of infectious diseases, and maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

For specialized medical services in this field, students seeking such care are referred to specialized public health institutions in coordination with the university's Preventive Medicine Service.
