Submission Guidelines

Authors are invited to submit original, unpublished research papers that are not being considered for publication elsewhere. Submissions should adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Length:** Full papers (12-15+ pages) and short papers (6-11 pages).
- **Format:** Papers must be formatted according to the conference template and be written in English.
- **Plagiarism Check:** All papers will be checked for plagiarism using Turnitin to ensure originality.
- **Review Process:** Each paper will undergo a double-blind peer-review process by at least three qualified reviewers.

Submissions must be made via the conference's submission system (<https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ICDAIS2026>).

Proceedings

The proceeding will be published in the Springer Communications in Computer and Information Science (CCIS) series, ensuring high visibility and indexing in major databases such as DBLP, Google Scholar, EI-Compendex, Mathematical Reviews, SCImago, Scopus. The authors of selected papers will be invited to prepare a substantially revised and extended version of Indexed Journals (Pending).
