- Applicants must be lecturers at Abbes Laghrou University of Khenchela;
- A copy of a valid passport;
- An official certificate confirming the applicant's administrative rank or position within the pedagogical team of the Department;
- Completion of the attached CV template for this call, to be uploaded in the designated section of the application link;
- A certificate demonstrating proficiency in English or Italian (accepted certificates include TOEFL, IELTS, or a certificate issued by the Intensive Centre of Languages – CEIL Khenchela). Alternatively, or in addition, applicants may provide certificates attesting that they have taught courses in English or Italian;
- Any additional supporting documents, such as certifications related to the Erasmus+ framework, pedagogical activities, or international collaborations.
